Andy Evansen's interest in art started in childhood, as he can't recall a time when he wasn't drawing. He began painting watercolors in the mid 1990s as a change of pace from his career as a medical illustrator. Choosing a 'style' was not difficult, as Andy was always inspired by the watercolor paintings of British artists Trevor Chamberlain, David Curtis, Ed Seago and Edward Wesson, among others.

He found himself attempting to capture the landscape with the same economy of brushstroke, taking advantage of the luminosity of watercolors done in just a few washes. In addition, he was impressed with the way those artists seemed to capture everyday scenes in such a way that revealed a hidden beauty, subjects that many would simply pass by.

His work gained recognition after winning an international watercolor competition through



American Artist magazine, appearing on their cover in 2005. He's been featured in numerous other publications since, and has become a sought-after workshop instructor who paints and teaches internationally. He became a signature member of the prestigious Plein Air Painters of America (PAPA) in 2012 and served as their President from 2015-2017. His paintings have won numerous awards, including the Bronze and High Winds Medals from the American Watercolor Society, and he was their demonstration artist for the 2018 Exhibition. His love of painting on location also led to him being a featured presenter at the 2014 and 2016 Plein Air Conventions and inclusion in the 2017 Qingdao International Masters Watercolor Plein Air Event. He is a Signature Member of AWS, PAPA, RRWS, TWSA.



She joined the Valley Watercolor Society and won first place for several

Her family held a Celebration of Life on January 5th in Southern California, where many of her original paintings, sculptures and books were featured. She will be greatly missed.

Gayle Garner Roski is one of the exhibiting artists in the Masters of the American West Exhibition and Sale at the Autry Museum, on view February 8-March 22. Her works in this year's display, now in its 23rd year, feature images of Kachina dolls, the delightful figures carved out of wood by the Hopi to teach young girls about the spirits that are central to their way of life. With two of her paintings for the Masters, Gayle continues a personal

tradition of incorporating a small treasure, a memento that provided inspiration during her creative process. Treasures that have been affixed to the frames of previous works include Italian pottery, Indian jewelry, Zulu baskets, Chinese calligraphy brushes and Chinese snuff bottles. The Kachina dolls adorning watercolor paintings for the 2020 Masters Exhibition are "Tawa," the Sunface that represents the spirit of the sun, and "Kwahu" – the Eagle – the messenger between the people and their spirit guides. Workshop Policy: The workshop fee includes a 10% non-refundable cancellation fee if a cancellation is made more than 30 days prior to the workshop. A 50% non-refundable fee if cancellation is made between 30 or 7 days. No refund will be made for a NO SHOW or a cancellation with less than 7 days of notice prior to the workshop. The workshop may be cancelled at the discretion of the Workshop Chair and the President if any of the following occur: there are less than 10 participants, the workshop is not at a financial breakeven point, or the demonstrator or location cancels. In this case, FULL refunds will be given. If for any reason your check or credit card payment is rejected by your bank, VWS will ask you for a reimbursement if any fine or charge is assessed by your bank to VWS. After two incidents, membership will be revoked.
