Born, raised and classically trained in China, **Shuang Li** received her BA Degree in Graphic Design and Master Degree in Art History. After moving to the United States, **Shuang Li** received her MFA (Master of Fine Art) Degree from The Department of Art, University of Oregon in 1991.

Following the traditional "En Plein Air" Impressionism approach, Shuang paints watercolor both on locations and in her studio, and

portrays the extraordinary variety of life with her unique perspective. With masterful classic and contemporary techniques, Shuang recreates nature's beauty in her paintings by capturing moods and moments of light and color with her singular poetic expression.

A signature member of National Watercolor Society, Watercolor West, San Diego Watercolor Society and LPAPA, Shuang's artworks have long been favored by collectors, also regularly exhibited in national and international galleries and group shows, with many honorable awards. With her extensive teaching background, Shuang has been regularly invited by art organizations for her popular plein air painting demonstrations, art workshops and classes. She also frequently serves as an invited juror for art competitions and art exhibitions.

Workshops are normally held for one to three days from 9am – 4pm.

While our workshops are online we will have reduced prices, and reduced hours, held from 9am – 12pm (PST)

**Workshop Policy:** The workshop fee includes a 10% non-refundable cancellation fee if a cancellation is made more than 30 days prior to the workshop. A 50% non-refundable fee if cancellation is made between 30 or 7 days. No refund will be made for a NO SHOW or a cancellation with less than 7 days of notice prior to the workshop. The workshop may be cancelled at the discretion of the Workshop Chair and the President if any of the following occur: there are less than 10 participants, the workshop is not at a financial breakeven point, or the demonstrator or location cancels. In this case, FULL refunds will be given. If for any reason your check or credit card payment is rejected by your bank, VWS will ask you for a reimbursement if any fine or charge is assessed by your bank to VWS. After two incidents, membership will be revoked.


