Liz Walker, who creates award-winning acrylic and marbled paintings in her home studio in the Portland, Oregon area has been painting and teaching throughout the Pacific Northwest for over 20 years. Abstracted figures that convey a sense of "story" are her favorite subject matter, and she produces hundreds of paintings each year.

Liz started out painting in watercolor in 1991 but in 2006, switched to acrylics, collage, and marbling to create her imaginative works. She received her BA in Art from Trinity University in San Antonio, TX. Her work has been exhibited in regional and national juried shows, and in 2020 she received First Place in the 47th Annual Rocky Mountain Watermedia Exhibit for her black and white painting "Upon Closer Inspection".

Her paintings have been published in several North Light publications, including Watercolor Magazine. She is a Signature member of the National Watercolor Society, Northwest Watercolor Society, San Diego Watercolor Society, Western Federation of Watercolor Societies, and the International Society of Experimental Artists.

After attending UCLA and earning her degree in Fine Arts, Susie spent her entire adult life as an artist both in the commercial graphics world and in the genre of watercolors and monotypes, which she loved. Her admiration for her great uncle, Philip Guston, inspired Susie and informed the foundation of her work. Her love for travel with family, friends, and other artists enabled Susie to exhibit her works throughout the United States and internationally, while also devoting her life to teaching other artists over the course of 30 years with the gifted group, Artist Co-Op 7.


Susie had many wonderful friends, and she particularly enjoyed playing Mahjong in three different groups each week. A giving person who shared her love for the arts, Susie served on the board of

counsilors at the USC Roski School of Art and Design. She was an integral part of the Jewish Artists Initiative, maintained active memberships in the Valley Watercolor Society, Collage Artists of America, and other organizations, earning multiple awards for her work. Susie also enjoyed her membership at Brentwood Country Club with her husband and family.

Susie supported many charitable organizations including Stephen S. Wise Temple, Milken Community High School, USC Hillel, Los Angeles Youth Orchestra, USC School of Architecture, Jewish Federation of Los Angeles, Camp Alonim, and Inner City Arts.

Workshop Policy: The workshop fee includes a 10% non-refundable cancellation fee if a cancellation is made more than 30 days prior to the workshop. A 50% non-refundable fee if cancellation is made between 30 or 7 days. No refund will be made for a NO SHOW or a cancellation with less than 7 days of notice prior to the workshop. The workshop may be cancelled at the discretion of the Workshop Chair and the President if any of the following occur: there are less than 10 participants, the workshop is not at a financial breakeven point, or the demonstrator or location cancels. In this case, FULL refunds will be given. If for any reason your check or credit card payment is rejected by your bank, VWS will ask you for a reimbursement of any fine or charge assessed by your bank to VWS. After two incidents, membership will be revoked.
