## June Demo Artist: Alexis Lavine, NWS






I was a passionate plein air painter for many years. Recently, I have been working more in my studio, where I can slow down my brush and take more time to design and craft my paintings with the utmost of care, to create the most impact in my work and communicate with my viewers as effectively as possible. I have discovered a new fascination with the clothed human figure, and have been focusing on telling stories, using grouping, cropping, and placement of the figures within my picture plane.



Education is tremendously important. I earned two bachelor degrees and a master's degree, before embarking on my path as a painter. I continue to study art whenever possible, and I also teach painting and drawing classes and workshops. I love to speak about art, share my experience and knowledge, and help my students achieve greater success.

I am a signature member of the National Watercolor Society, Watercolor Honor Society, Transparent Watercolor Society of America, Watercolor West, Northeast Watercolor Society, and Southern Watercolor Society. Recently honored as "One to Watch" by <u>Watercolor Artist Magazine</u>, my paintings have been published in <u>Splash</u>, <u>The Artistic Touch</u>, <u>The Best of Watercolor</u>, <u>Watercolor Artist</u>, and <u>The New Palette</u>. Creative Art Press has published a five-DVD instructional series, called "Creative Watercolor Painting Using Photos" featuring my watercolor demos.

### **ALEXIS LAVINE Workshop Descriptions - June 22 & 23**





"Design for Success!" This workshop focuses on enhancing paintings through strategic design, creative drawing, and effective techniques. During demos, I explain my process in detail with a clear Zoom view, answering questions throughout. Critiques are positive, emphasizing strengths and offering improvement suggestions. I provide individual feedback via shared screens. After demos, I spend the rest of the class on one-on-one discussions, reviewing student projects and offering guidance. Students send photos for review, and we discuss progress via screen sharing. Detailed pre-workshop information, daily recaps, and Zoom recordings are provided to reinforce learning.

# Kathleen Scoggin Demo on 5/9/24 General Meeting

Kathleen Scoggin gave a fun demo of her approach to abstract designs. She uses various tools such as wax, crayon, pastel pencils to supplement and enhance the design in watercolor. She typically starts with two analogous colors and adds a third complementary color to complete the palette.

workshop Policy: The workshop fee includes a 10% non-refundable cancellation fee if a cancellation is made more than 30 days prior to the workshop. A 50% non-refundable fee if cancellation is made between 30 or 7 days. No refund will be made for a NO SHOW or a cancellation with less than 7 days of notice prior to the workshop. The workshop may be cancelled at the discretion of the Workshop Chair and the President if any of the following occur: there are less than 10 participants, the workshop is not at a financial breakeven point, or the demonstrator or location cancels. In this case, FULL refunds will be given. If for any reason your check or credit card payment is rejected by your bank, VWS will ask you for a reimbursement of any fine or charge assessed by your bank to VWS. After two incidents, membership will be revoked.
